IN-SCHOOL SUSPENSION ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

The following procedures will apply to in-school suspension of students.

- A. Students will report directly to the in-school suspension (ISS) room in the morning.
- B. Students will work on assignments provided by subject teachers.
- C. Students will use all time in ISS for productive activities.
- D. No conversation is permitted.
- E. Students will eat lunch in the ISS room.
- F. Students will be given permission to use the bathroom during class periods only, and not during passing time.
- G. All assigned time must be completed before return to regular classes.
- H. During ISS, students are prohibited from participation in or attendance at any school extracurricular or social activity.
- I. The emphasis of the ISS program is an isolation from other students.
